

## Mark Corner – curriculum vitae

Mark Corner was born in London in 1953. He has published six academic books, including two works of political thought related to the EU and its uniqueness as a sovereignty-sharing institution, *The Binding of Nations: From European Union to World Union* (London: Palgrave Macmillan 2010) and *The EU: An Introduction* (London: I B Tauris, 2014)

He taught in universities in England (Newcastle upon Tyne), the Czech Republic (Charles University, Prague) and Belgium (KU Leuven). While in Newcastle he also spent four years as a Labour councillor.

He continues to teach economic history and philosophy for KULEuven as an emeritus. He has also translated several works of Czech literature into English, which have been published by the Karolinum Press in Prague in cooperation with the University of Chicago Press in the USA. He remains interested in politics and economics and is currently writing a book entitled *A Tale of Two Unions* comparing the British Union of four with the European Union of twenty-seven.
